

## Electronic Inter-County Transfer Capability Live Across California!

Electronic Inter-County Transfers (eICT) is LIVE in production across the State. Case information and related images can now be exchanged electronically between any county in California. The eICT project was delivered in production in all three California automated welfare systems consortia (CalWIN, C-IV, and LEADER) on schedule March 28, 2011.

The eICT project is a significant achievement that will help ensure client benefits continue when relocating to a different county. The CalWIN team, in close collaboration with the C-IV and LEADER teams, played an essential role in the change effort, providing project management of the design, development and documentation of the solution.

The implementation was supported by a state Command Center as well as Consortia Status calls. No major issues have been reported in production and only a handful of Service Requests have been received. Processing will continue to be closely monitored over the early stages of the product.

The response to the eICT project from State agencies has been very positive. At the initial Go/No-Go meeting with the State and other consortia, CWDA's Meg Sheldon stated that she was very pleased and called the accomplishment *"Awesome!"* and *praised the* cross-consortia collaboration and coordination. WCDS provided a demonstration of the eICT capabilities to the California Department of Social Services (CDSS), which was extremely well-received. Staff from CDSS sent an email stating that *"the demonstration was FANTASTIC and the crew did an amazing job presenting it."*

The success of this project is a direct result of the stellar eICT project teams from each Consortium, to include their vendors and and County representatives. Congratulations to all who were involved in this impressive accomplishment!
