

## Semi-Annual Reporting Awarded “Project of the Year”

The CalWIN Semi-Annual Reporting Project (CR5888) was recognized in March as the Project Management Institute – Sacramento Valley Chapter (PMI SVC) Project of the Year for 2013. The award is for the project best “Illustrating Outstanding Application of Project Management Principles and Practices.”
